

About Dinesh D'Souza . . .

Dinesh D'Souza personifies the American immigrant success story. Born in India in 1961, D'Souza came to the US at seventeen on a Rotary Club exchange program. In 1979 he moved to New Hampshire to major in English at Dartmouth College. There he wrote for the campus newspaper, worked in the international students' association, joined an energy conservation committee, and helped start the *Dartmouth Review*, a politically conservative magazine.

While still in his twenties, and not yet a citizen, he was invited to participate in the Reagan White House as a domestic policy advisor. He has written several *New York Times* best-selling books, among them, *Life After Death* and *What's So Great About Christianity*, which is the basis of the lectures on March 19-20. Though born into a Christian family, he readily admits his was a perfunctory faith. In the last twenty years, however, his faith has deepened and blossomed to the point where many have compared his book, *What's So Great About Christianity*, to the great apologetic works of C. S. Lewis.

D'Souza's Christian works are characterized by deep thinking, extensive research from sources of the last 3000 years, and an engaging style, which clarifies difficult ideas in a very accessible way. He uses ideas from the great philosophers, such as Nietzsche and Schopenhauer, the results of the latest ideas from physics, and writings of great Christian thinkers, such as Saint Augustine to demolish the arguments

against God presented in recent works by Dawkins, Harris, Hitchens, *et al.* As a speaker, D'Souza is exciting and inspirational.

D'Souza splits his time between Southern California and New York City, where he is President of The King's College, a Christian liberal arts college.
