CHAPTER TWO – TEAM BYLAWS

**Section 4**  
**Constitution & Bylaws Team**  
(Adopted February 21, 2016)

1) Formation

- a) The Constitution and By-Laws Team shall consist of three members, nominated by the Nominating Team and elected by majority vote of the church at the July Business Meeting.
- b) The Constitution and By-Laws Team shall elect a Team Leader at its first scheduled meeting following the July Business Meeting.
- c) Constitution and By-Laws Team members must be members of the church.
- d) The Constitution and By-Laws Team shall elect one of its members to serve as its representative on the Administrative Council. This representative may, but is not required to be, the Team Leader of the Constitution and By-Laws Team.

2) Term of Office

- a) Members of the Constitution and By-Laws Team shall serve three-year terms such that one term expires each year.
- b) Constitution and By-Laws Team members may be re-elected for a second three-year term but must rotate off the Constitution and By-Laws Team following the conclusion of any second term for a mandatory one-year period before becoming re-eligible for Constitution and By-Laws Team membership.

3) Duties

The Constitution and By-Laws Team shall:

- a) periodically review the Constitution and By-Laws of the church and make recommendations for needed and appropriate updates,
- b) assist persons, teams, and/or councils of the church in reviewing constitutional questions and in the preparation and wording of constitutional amendments,
- c) following the July Business Meeting and prior to the October Business Meeting, conduct its first meeting, and
- d) meet at least annually, with additional meetings scheduled as needed.
