MOTIONS FROM PERSONNEL COMMITTEE PASSED AT BUSINESS MEETING!

September 26, 2010

Upon Clay's death, Mary Mann took on a significant amount of administrative duties while continuing her job as Associate Pastor of Music. She has consistently worked a minimum of 40 hours per week since June, 2009. With Michael's resignation effective 8/31/10, Mary is required to oversee additional administrative duties.

The Personnel Committee moved and the following motion was approved unanimously:

That Mary Mann's position become full-time effective September 1, 2010 and her title be adjusted to read **Associate Pastor**, *with specific duties in music and administration*. This will be continued until such time as the church or Mary re-evaluates her position and hours of work. It is understood that as a fulltime minister at Tomahawk Baptist Church, Mary shall receive compensatory salary as well as annuity benefits.

In regard to our Youth Ministry and the vacancy we have with Michael Sepulveda's resignation the Personnel Committee recommended the following motion, which also passed without dissent:

That Emily Hodges' part time Youth intern position be extended from September 1, 2010 until December 31, 2010, with a contract salary rate of \$1000.00 per month with no additional benefits. Emily will work approximately 20 hours per week in addition to attending all youth activities (Emily knows our youth, is trusted by them and has helped plan most of the fall 2010 Youth activities.)

A second motion in regard to our Youth Ministry also was approved:

That Tomahawk Baptist Church employ the Rev. Drew Collier as **Interim Part-Time** Youth Minister beginning October 4, 2010 at an annual salary of \$21,500 with no additional benefits. This part time position will be 20 hours per week and can be terminated by either party with written notice.

In addition to these timely decisions, the church also approved the **Budget Committee's motion for approving a refinancing of the church mortgage** for 11 remaining years at 5.61% through Union First Market Bank using the church property as required collateral. The committee was authorized to proceed with the proposed financial plan.

NEXT YEAR'S BUDGET

The Budget Committee, under Sherry Graves's leadership, has been preparing the 2011 Church Budget for an October 17 vote by the congregation. In order to interpret new budget details and priorities, the Committee will hold a couple of "listening sessions" with the congregation in October: Wednesdays, October 6 and 13 at supper (5:45-6:15pm). Please pray for God's wisdom as Tomahawk looks to an important next year--financially, and pastorally! Dan Bagby
