1. The Bible seems to allow room for personal choice on the use or non-use of alcohol. Why do you think this might be the case? Would you prefer the Bible to speak definitively to the topic either declaring it in or out of bounds?
2. Describe the view toward alcohol in the home you grew up in. How has that view influenced your current outlook? Would you be happy if your children or grandchildren adopted the same view toward alcohol that you practice?
3. What is it about us that, once we've reached a decision on a topic such as the use of alcohol, gives us a tendency to be judgmental towards those who reach a different perspective?
4. Current views toward the use of alcohol in most church circles has tended to relax considerably over those of the previous generation. Express your thoughts on the subject. Is the change good or bad? What are the benefits AND risks associated with the change?
5. The stated goal of the message was for you to adopt an intentional, wise, God-honoring posture toward your use or non-use of alcohol. Have you done so? What is your current posture and why?
