- ✓ That all who truly believe in Christ will live a life of obedience in faith to God's Word, and spend eternity in the presence of God as His people (Acts 26:20; Ezekiel 36:26-27; Titus 3:8; Ephesians 2:10; Revelation 21:3)
- ✓ These are all absolute truths that God has told us in His Word about Himself. (Romans 3:4; Proverbs 30:5-6; John 14:6)
- ✓ Therefore you must repent and believe because it is true and only in Jesus can anyone find eternal life. (1 John 2:23-23; John 20:31; Galatians 3:22)

If your heart and mind is convinced of these truths, you must not delay, repent of your sin and believe in Jesus Christ and be baptised in accordance with the Scriptures.

Cry out to God for mercy and He will have compassion on you.

- ✓ That when God made the first man, Adam then sinned, and it caused all his decedents to be born sinners, spiritually dead, slaves of and sin, and under condemnation, all are guilty sinners (Genesis 2:16-17, 3:6; Romans 5:12,16-17)
- ✓ That God, in love, sent His divine eternal Son into the world in as a man, Jesus Christ. (John 3:16; 1 John 4:9-10)
- ✓ That Jesus Christ was fully God and fully man, a mysterious truth (Colossians 1:19, 2:9, Philippians 2:8)
- ✓ That only Jesus alone, being divine and sinless, the righteousness of God, was fit to pay the penalty, taking God's wrath, for sinners like you and me (Hebrews 7:26; 10:11-14; 1 John 3:5)
- ✓ That Christ died on the cross, bearing the sin and punishment, to ransom, redeem, reconcile, propitiate, justify and guarantee

- of all that is needed for that salvation of His people. (Mathew 1:21, 10:28; John 10:15; Romans 3, 26, 4:5, 8:33; Titus 2:14, 3:7; 1 Peter 2:24)
- ✓ That Jesus, being both Lord and Saviour, rose from the dead on the third day by God's power in accord with God's plan (Luke 18:31-33; Acts 2:22-23; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4)
- ✓ That Jesus will come again and Judge everyone who ever lived (Acts 10:42, 17:31; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-12)
- ✓ That there is absolutely nothing we can do to save ourselves, no works, not contribution, true salvation is by grace alone (Titus 3:5-6; Romans 9:16; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 1:3, 21)
- ✓ That God commands all people everywhere to repent (genuine grief over sins and turning from self and sin to God) and believe in Jesus Christ alone (all that He was, said, did and will do) and be baptised in the name of the Father the Son, and the Holy Spirit (Isaiah 45:22; John 17:3; Mark 1:15; Acts 2:28, 14:15, 26:18-20; Romans 4:21-25, 10:9)
- ✓ That God's saving grace has enabled, by the power of the Holy Spirit bringing them to new life, all who turn from sin to follow Christ in faith. (Titus 3:5-7; 2 Thessalonians 2:13; 1 Peter 1:2-5)
- ✓ That there is no other god(s), salvation, or true hope or acceptance with God but in Christ through faith (Deuteronomy 4:35, 39; Isaiah 45:5, 14, 18; Galatians 4:8; Acts 4:12)
- ✓ That all who do not believe in Christ will suffer eternal punishment (John 3:18; Mathew 25:46; 2 Thessalonians 1:8)
- ✓ That because of Christ, all who are born again (made alive spiritually), have Christ's perfect righteousness counted as theirs by faith, are set free from sin and condemnation and are indwelt and led by the Holy Spirit (John 3:3-8; Romans 4:5, 5:15-17, 6:18, 8:14; 1Corinthians 15:45-48 Ephesians 2:5; Colossians 2:13)
