Pay ONLY \$5 per camper if you register by Friday, May 15th.

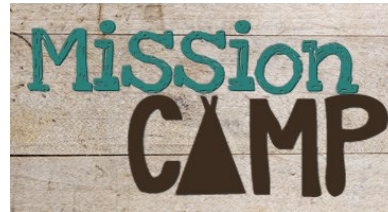
After paying for two participants the cost is \$5 per child.
