### i4: Imagining what God Will Do: by Bill Moore & Mark Fuller

Four sessions to help you own God's vision for Trinity Church. In this study, you'll explore the biblical themes of intimacy with God, inner transformation, intentional community, and impacting the world. Each session includes a short introduction, individual and group bible study questions, and practical spiritual exercises to put the vision into practice in your life.



# **Intimacy with God**

### God is Closer than You Think: by John Ortberg

Six Sessions on Experiencing the Presence of God The story of the Bible is the story of God's desire to be with people. God is extending himself, stretching out to reach us, to fill our lives with his presence. Every moment of your life is like a page in a *Where's Waldo?* book.
