**WELCOME TO TRINITY**

It's great that you have joined us today. We hope your time with us will be both inspiring and spiritually helpful. Perhaps you are new to this whole church thing and are not sure what to expect. We want you to feel comfortable. So here's what a typical Sunday might look like:

**Service:** We will begin with some singing followed by a time of learning together from the Bible. Most Sundays we have communion together. The leaders will often explain why we do what we do.

**Offering:** In support of Trinity's ministries, we take a collection toward the end of the service. Feel free to also use the offering boxes beside the sanctuary doors.

**Children + Youth: Programs are offered for Infants - Grade 5.** After the first couple of songs, all of the kids will be dismissed and head downstairs. If you have not yet signed them in, please do so at the table in the foyer. Your little ones are welcome to stay with you or can be brought to the nursery/toddler room downstairs at the beginning of (or during) the service. We are a relaxed spiritual family, and we love having babies around with their noise and the energy they bring! **Junior High Youth** can go downstairs (after the kids dismissal) for a bible study during our 9:15 service.

**After the Service:** Hang around and meet some members from our church family. Check out the Library or grab a beverage and a snack in lobby.

**Memorial Flower Program:**

Please be advised that our existing method of signing up and paying for memorial flowers has changed.

You may purchase a potted flowering plant (low allergy variety please) and bring it to the church on the Saturday morning, if you wish to give memorial flowers in the auditorium or hall. Roy's Flowers would be happy to advise you in your selection. Any memorial wording that you would like to be printed in bulletin must be submitted in writing or on The City, two weeks prior to the monthly bulletin publication.

### THE ALPHA COURSE

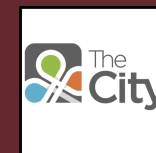
The Course continues to run through the months of October and November. We ask that you would continue to keep the leaders and participants in your prayers.
