

Our Story:

- Trinity's founders were encouraged to align themselves with the Evangelical Free Church of America and have remained affiliated with the EFCA since their beginning.
- In 1969 Trinity began as a home Bible study and soon grew enough to share a local church building on Sundays.
- In 1972 this small but growing congregation committed themselves to build what now is our main worship sanctuary.
- In 1988 additional Christian Education space and church offices were added. Then in 1998 our Ministry Outreach Center was built to include a gymnasium, full stage for drama, state of the art kitchen and additional classrooms. These additions have greatly enriched our ability to minister to our own church family as well as our neighboring community.
- In 2008 we celebrated the retirement of all debt on our building. This enabled us to focus more attention and resources on fulfilling the Great Commission.
- In 2011 we added our CrossWalk service in the gymnasium which complements our worship services in the main sanctuary, offering a bit more informal setting to worship.
- We continue to look toward the fields that are 'white unto harvest' as God uses Trinity in our community and around the world.
