Christmas Carol Spotlight

"Hark The Herald Angels Sing"

If all of Charles Wesley's words to this hymn had remained we would be singing, "Hark! How All the welkin rings, Glory to the King of kings. "Welkin" as Wesley intended it means "vault of heaven." It first appeared in Wesley's *Hymns and Sacred Poems*, published in 1739. The next publication was in *A Collection of Hymns for Social Worship* by Wesley's colleague, George Whitefield. Whitefield changed the words of the first stanza to those sung today. Charles Wesley preferred slow, solemn tunes for his texts, but the tune now associated with the carol is from a Felix Mendelssohn cantata. Mendelssohn himself said of the music, "it will never do to sacred word," but in 1857 William H. Cummings, a great Mendelssohn admirer, combined the two and in 1857 the hymn was published in the *Congregational Hymn and Tune Book*. The combination has endured these 154 years.
