At the congregational assembly last Sunday, the voters approved the recommendation to issue a divine call to Rev. TREASURER’S UPDATE

June 30th concluded our fiscal year for the 2016/17 budget. We ended up \$48,000 better than budget, which was good news. This was primarily due to strong enrollment and revenue from our Early Childhood Academy and School Academy, which performed a combined \$158,177 better than budget! One growing concern is our general offering at both the DT and FC sites. Our general giving ended up \$51,178 below budget for the fiscal year and down \$73,236 compared to the previous year. Overall our giving was down 8% as compared to last year. I am looking forward to the renewed focus and importance on stewardship to achieve all that God has in store for us in this new fiscal year.
