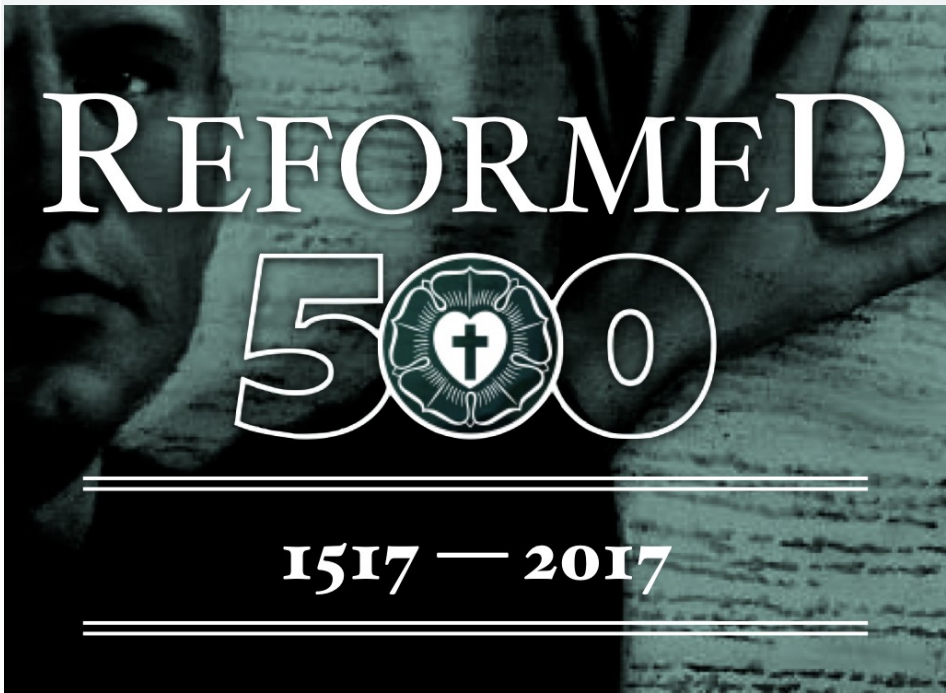

On October 31, 1517, Martin Luther nailed 95 theses (statements) to the door of Wittenberg's Castle Church. The statements showed many of the errors of the Roman Catholic Church's teaching and governance, and appealed for people to understand the freedom they had in Christ. That event began what we know as the Reformation. This month marks the 500th anniversary of those postings. TREASURER'S UPDATE

The Finance Committee has identified the need for a renewed focus on the Property Improvement Fund (PIF) and long-term financial health of Trinity. The PIF secures funds to pay for expensive repairs/improvements to our properties that fall outside our standard budget. We have identified over \$200,000 worth of needs initially that the PIF will address. These needs include the replacement of the DT parking lot, repairs to the FC parking lot, shingles for the FC roof, and the replacement of the DT boiler. We would like to replace the DT parking lot as soon as the fund balance reaches \$55,000. Please consider donating to the PIF. Blessings, Pete
