The Trinity Council met on September 12, 2011. Council reviewed the August Financial Report.

Sharon Becker presented the quarterly Missions Board report. Giving to missions is on target. The Missions Board is working on a banner project with each banner reading %Jesus Loves Me+in a different language. Trinity is now giving support to seven countries. The %Branches of Hope+ donations are being taken now in the Narthex for %River of Life+in Romania. The August 2011 Missions Convention was a great success. Sharon reported on several Trinity members who have gone or will be going on mission trips.

Kerry Belitz and Pastor White reported on preparations for the %Raise the Roof+ fundraiser. Mike and Beth Drinnin have agreed to co-chair the event. It will be held at the Church on November 6. There will be a meeting Wednesday, September 14, to discuss auction items.

Council discussed the use of facilities. The Kids of the Kingdom is now closed and materials will be cleaned up in those rooms on October 15. Room 11 is now in use. Nursery design and Prayer Room design committees are needed. Pastor White will set up the committees.

Pastor White reported that Karen Rahtz will be the new Parish Secretary starting September 19.

Pastor White reported that Darwin Anderson will speak on Rededication Weekend October 29-30. The topic will be %First Things First.+

Training and procedures for medical emergencies during services will be addressed.

The next Council meeting will be October 10, 2011.





"RAISE THE ROOF"....IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT STOPPING LEAKS *by Pastor White*

On Sunday, November 6, we'll all have the opportunity to participate in something never before done at Trinity. "Raise the Roof" is a dinner and auction event (sounds like fun) to pay off the cost of the recently replaced roof we're all enjoying at Church.

Background

Many of you are aware of the sad condition of the flat portion of our roof last spring: dark water stains on many ceiling tiles and buckets or trash baskets sitting around the hallways and various rooms collecting water. We were no longer keeping up by patching leaks. The Church Council knew we needed to get the work done over the summer months and so requested funding from the Trinity Endowment Trust Fund. The Endowment Board very graciously offered to cover half the cost of the project outright and to extend a loan to the Church for the other half. The roof replacement was approved by congregational vote in May. Though we have not yet received the final bill, it is expected to be in the \$85,000 to \$90,000 range, so it's anticipated that we may need to come up with \$45,000 to pay off the loan. Some funds have already been donated toward this.



Anticipate a Fun Event

In considering how to raise the money we would need, instead of just sending out another fund-raising letter to church members, the Council wanted to have an event that would serve the additional purposes of creating fellowship and good will. The dinner and auction formula has worked effectively for other church and civic organizations in Columbus.

"Raise The Roof" - and What You Can Do

Tickets for a steak dinner are \$30. Seating will be limited for the dinner, but people don't need to attend the dinner to participate in the auction. See "Raise the Roof" information on the previous page for all the details. Mike and Beth Drinnin are "Raise the Roof" Co-Chairs and are also chairing the Dinner Committee. Tickets/Marketing is being led by Michelle Stirek and Lisa Cherry. Co-Chairs for the Logistics Committee are Darryl and Joy Anderson. The Auction Committee is chaired by Rex and Lisa Davies. You can help by purchasing dinner tickets, attending the auction and by considering donations to either the silent auction or the live auction. Of course, outright donations designated for the roof replacement loan are still welcome.
