



Mrs. Schmitzer's 3-year old Preschool Supply List

- Tote bag or backpack *****pretty please, label THE OUTSIDE with your child's first or last name or even initials** (this helps us get all children packed up and ready to go home quickly)*******
Also please make sure that a school folder can fit without being folded in half ☺
- A change of clothes in a **gallon ziploc bag with your child's name on the bag** (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks) Even if your child is far beyond the "accident stage," we still have snack and craft accidents. I guarantee, if your child does not have a change of clothes here, he/she will need it ☺ It ALWAYS works out that way.
- A composition notebook **labeled with your child's name**. It doesn't matter what size the lines are. We will be using it for "Preschool Journaling" which is mostly drawing pictures and tracing.

DO NOT LABEL THE FOLLOWING WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME -

IT ALL GOES INTO ONE BIG PILE ☺

- 1 box crayons (24 count)
- One box of Ziploc bags, any size
- 1 container of antibacterial wipes

I also teach a class of 4 year olds who will be bringing in supplies (like markers and tissues). We all share all of our supplies except for extra clothes and journals!! I try hard to keep the list minimal. If there is something that we need later in the school year, I will send notes home with requests.
