## GUIDELINES FOR TRINITY TEAMS SUPPLYING FOOD FOR STREET CHURCH

We at Street Life are asking our volunteers to provide the following items with their meal:

- 1) Four (4) Main dishes in 12.75x20.75 inch disposable aluminum trays for estimated 70 people, which will vary from time-to-time. Coordinator will keep you updated. These aluminum trays are available at Costco Redwood City, and there will usually be some available in advance in the Trinity kitchen.
- 2) Three (3) side dishes in 12.75x20.75 inch aluminum trays are required for each meal.
- 3) Two (2) cases of water at 30 or 36 bottles per case.
- 4) Three (3) 16 oz. bottles of Salad dressing.
- 5) Desserts are optional. Street Life normally provides. If you provide desserts, then let Street Life know so they can reduce what they bring.
- 6) Please make sure all hot items are fully cooked and come from your oven very hot. Street Life will measure the internal temperature of the food before placing it into our hot-boxes, and it must be at least 140 degrees F. for food safety purposes.
- 7) Five (5) people should go to the Street Church location to serve the food. If you cannot provide 5 people, please let us know as early as possible so we can arrange backups.

We at Street Life ask that when you prepare your meal that you please take a few minutes to pray for all those who will be eating your meal that night and also pray for GOD to move in big ways to show the lost and needy some light in his/her life.

What Street Life will provide for the meal:

- 1) All dishware, utensils, napkins, serving spoons, etc.
- 2) Salad, Bread and Dessert.
- 3) We will pick up the food at your home or Church to bring meal to set location.
- 4) If you have any problem providing food, please notify your coordinator ASAP, so we can make up the difference with our overflow food in our kitchen. We have food donated to help you out in case you can not provide enough that night.

We are always looking for new ways to make things easier for you. We will inform you as soon as we are able to take anything off your list of items to provide.

We at Street Life want to say thank you for what you are doing in providing a great hot meal to those who live on the street. Some of the folks who come and eat with us only get the one meal we serve in a day. Most days they go with no food or very little. You are providing such a great thing. We could not do what we do on the streets if it was not for the love you all show in every meal you make.

Just to give you a small idea, we serve over two hundred (200) mouths a week in two locations. In this, your meals have been able to give us the opportunity to share the Word of GOD to every single one who comes. Is that not what JESUS said, go share the good news or what?? So from the bottom of our hearts THANK YOU!!!!! We pray that we will be doing this for years to come only with the help and support of people such as yourselves.
