

About our services:

Chapel Service: Sunday, 8:00 AM in the chapel

This is an informal traditional 45 minute service with scripture, sermon, and hymns with organ accompaniment. Holy Communion is observed the first Sunday of the month and all are welcome to partake. Following the service, many of those attending meet at a local restaurant for breakfast and fellowship.

Traditional Service: Sunday, 9:15 AM in the Sanctuary

This is a more formal traditional service with liturgy, scripture, sermon, hymns with organ accompaniment, and a children's moment. September thru May the Chancel Choir sings and June-August a variety of vocal and instrumental solos and ensembles provide special music. Holy Communion is observed the first Sunday of the month and all are welcome to partake.

Kindling Service: Sunday, 11:11 AM in the Fellowship Hall

This is an alternative worship service with scripture, sermon, with contemporary Christian songs led by *Revive*, our Praise Band. A service constructed especially for youth and families, It has a more informal worship setting with multiple seating choices: padded chairs, round tables, and in the attached Annex room a couch and oversized chairs, as well as a children's corner with small tables and chairs. 2 small bookcases in this area are loaded with child friendly worship materials. Large TV screens are positioned around the 2 areas so that no matter where you sit you can participate in the worship experience. Holy Communion is observed the first Sunday of the month and all are welcome to partake.
