This is a safety program designed just for children entering Kindergarten. Morning and evening sessions are available

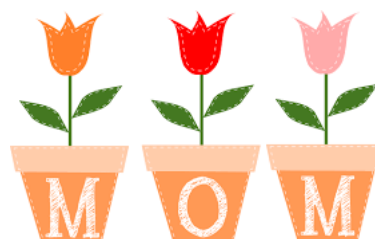
**June 4-8, 2018**
