MUSIC NOTES

Johann Gottfried Walther (1684-1748) based today’s Prelude on the Trinity Sunday chorale Allein Gott in der Höh sei Ehr’ by Nikolaus Decius (d. 1529); Decius’s chorale is derived in turn from a Gregorian chant setting of Gloria in excelsis Deo. The Offertory was written by Ruth Elaine Schram (b. 1956); the text is by her daughter, Celsie Staggers. The Communion music was composed in 1898 by Felix Borowski, a well-known Chicago musician and educator; we thank violinist Audrey Goodner for sharing her talents with us today! The 1987 Postlude is by British organist Sir Martin How MBE, who is noted for bringing greater vigor and immediacy to contemporary sacred music through his modern harmonies and syncopated rhythms.

Audrey Goodner will give a violin recital at 3 p.m., today in the sanctuary. She will feature works by Bach, Shostakovich, Kreisler and more. A reception will follow. All are invited to attend.
