## From Your Trustees

The Board of Trustees have a difficult task maintaining all the properties and facilities for our church. We again want to express our gratitude for the faith you have in us and the work we

We always strive to be diligent and faithful in our attempt to maintain our property in the most cost effective and efficient means possible.

We have identified several important capital needs we must address in the next two years.

First, as you are well aware, we continue to restore our stained glass windows. This past week the nativity window in the balcony was removed. As the restoration crew removed the window, they told us the window had deteriorated to the point it could have fallen out on its own.

The next phase, scheduled for late this year, is to complete the restoration of the dome windows. Even though we are getting close to the end of the overall project, the most expensive phase is ahead of us.

We have three other projects that need immediate attention. Over the past couple of years we have made several major improvements that have resulted in a substantial savings in energy cost. A new boiler was installed under the Sanctuary and many of the windows in the Education wing have been replaced.

The Trustees monitor our energy savings monthly and the result are positive. The replacement windows and new boiler are saving operating expenses.

With all this progress we still have more projects ahead of us.

- Stained Glass Windows Phase 8: Est. to complete is \$90,000
- Nursery window replacement: \$15,000
- Education Wing A/C: \$40,000
- Church Building Security System: \$30,000

As you can see the challenges are many. Each project is a need that must be met. opportunity to contribute and support each project is before us. We hope you will continue to support us with your prayers and aivina.
