The airplane captain has turned on the seat belt sign, indicating that we are entering an area of turbulence. "Please return to your seat now and fasten your seat belt." Flight attendants give that warning because unbuckled passengers can be injured. Secured in their seats, they can safely ride out the turbulence.

Most of the time, life doesn't warn us of the unsettling experiences coming our way. But our loving Father knows and cares about our struggles and He invites us to bring our cares, hurts and fears to Him. The Scriptures tell us, "Our High Priest understands our weaknesses, for He faced all of the same testings we do, yet He did not sin. So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive His mercy and we will find grace to help us when we need it most." (Hebrews 4:15-16)

In those rough times, going to our Father in prayer is the best thing we can do.
