## POLICY ON PETS

EFFECTIVE DATE: 11/17/05

**PURPOSE:** the purpose of this policy is to help ensure the health and safety of congregational members, children and visitors by limiting the access that pets have to the fellowship property. This policy is necessary to create a safe place for all whom come to UUFP. This policy will protect individuals who potentially may have allergies, asthma or other medical issues that limit contact to animals as well as protecting individuals from potentially being bitten or other wise injured by a pet.

**POLICY:** Pets and other animals are not allowed on UUFP property (including outdoor as well as indoor property) the following exceptions are noted:

1. Special circumstances with the expressed permission of the Board of Trustees.
2. Seeing eye dogs or animals
3. A program or service that is overseen and approved by the Program Committee.
