Fear of Witnessing (Sharing), A Great Tool of the Devil

I have struggled for many years to be an effective witness and have succeeded at times and have failed at other times. One of my biggest foes in being an effective witness has been my own fears. However, over the past few weeks, the Lord has been revealing to me a new perspective that is very liberating and very exciting. Let me see if I can adequately explain this.

I have worked hard at memorizing a "canned" formula of steps with memorized scriptures. This led me to be fearful of failing to memorize the steps and the scriptures word perfect. I tended to concentrate more on the "canned" formula rather than on the person that I was witnessing to. However, Praise the Lord that I still saw people come to faith in Christ. However, I now see that that was God's grace working in spite of me rather than because of me.

I have also allowed fear to squeeze me unmercifully because I feared that I would not be able to answer their questions. Sometimes I was so fearful that I failed to witness. At other times, I did witness but I communicated fear rather than the joy of the Lord.

As your pastor, I have been struggling over how I can lead all of you to be a more powerful and effective witness for the Lord. I know that this is the Lord's command to us, but helping all of us to move powerfully into this life of loving obedience has and is a very large challenge. I believe God is setting me free and I hope these thoughts and insights will help to move you to a new and exciting stage in your relationship with the Lord.

2 Corinthians 9:7-8 (NLT) ⁷You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully." ⁸And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.

This passage is mainly about sowing or giving of your resources. However, this is where the Lord has begun to give me a new perspective.

The Lord has been revealing to me that the starting point is to be "joyous." Many times when I think about witnessing, I confess that my starting point is "fear." 2 Corinthians 9:7 says that God loves a cheerful giver. There are so many reasons why my relationship with the Lord can be one of joy, in fact, overwhelming joy. The Lord has confronted me over making the joy that He brings to me the priority in my life. I need to stop letting fear be the priority in my life. I believe many of you also need to let the joy of the Lord be the priority in your lives.

When we begin to operate on the joy and the excitement that the Lord showers upon us, then witnessing becomes a privilege and joy to tell others about the joy and excitement that fills our lives. The sharing of our testimonies, what God has done and what He is doing in our lives, becomes the most important aspect of witnessing or sharing. Theological

debate and scripture memory is no longer the primary tool that the Lord uses in changed us. empowered lives are what the Lord wants to showcase to a lost and dying world. Rather than teaching more classes on witnessing, we would be better off encouraging you to love the Lord so much that it becomes simply impossible for you to keep it a secret. When you come to the point of loving the Lord your God with all of your heart, mind, and soul, then the look on your face, the words of your mouth, your character in times of crisis, and the focuses of your life cannot hide and camoflage the Lord Jesus in your life. You can try to hide Jesus, but you will fail because your love for Jesus will just overflow out of you.

Encouraging you to love the Lord Jesus Christ with all of your heart, mind, and soul will not be accomplished by having more Bible studies or more conferences. The key to the way that the Lord is revealing to me is found in **Proverbs 27:17 (NLT)** ¹⁷ As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend. This says to me that we need to build and encourage friendships that will sharpen each other. Sharpening each other means that we need to spur each other on to loving the Lord and doing His will. Is this possible? I don't believe that the Lord would be revealing these things if it were impossible. I believe that this is where He is desiring us to move in the life and ministry of Valley Isle Fellowship.

In the days and weeks to come, you will be hearing more and more of witnessing, discipling, ministry, worship, and fellowship that needs to be rooted and grounded in the "joy of the Lord." Valley Isle Fellowship needs to move all of us to fall more deeply in love with the Lord that the "joy of the Lord" will permeate and infiltrate every aspect of our life and ministry. Let us pray for each other that we will all love the Lord our God with all of our heart, mind, and soul.

You Are What You Eat



in the water. Imagine being this father who probably could never leave his son alone ever because he was afraid of what the evil spirit would do. His son surely had scars, both emotionally and physically from the torment he endured.

And he had come to Jesus, probably frustrated by the huge crowd around Jesus. He was unable to get through the crowd so he figured Jesus' disciples might be able to heal. But, they were powerless to heal the man's son. And so, this father in desperation calls out to Jesus. The father pleads with Jesus to heal the boy. Jesus says in verse 23 "if you can! All things are possible for one who believes." And then the father says something so profound that I want you to ponder this week. He cries out to Jesus "I believe; help my unbelief!" **Wow!** Have you ever thought about what this father was saying? Have you ever considered that often we are like this man? We believe intellectually but that intellectual belief in facts has not connected to our hearts and produced complete trust, surrender and hope in Jesus.

It's easy for us to not connect those two because we are so distracted by other things. We don't do the hard work of faith because it's easier to give up and turn on the TV or some other electronic device and comment on someone's Facebook status or picture. My plea for all of us is that we would strive to have the heart of this father because if we're honest, our hearts feel a lot like his a lot of times. We believe in facts but we have a hard time believing in the depths of our hearts that God is who he says he is and has done what he declares he has done...in my suffering, in my weariness, in my frustration, in my anger and in my depression. You see we know that God is good. We know that God is in control. We know that he has justified us forever. We know that He is gracious...but we don't really "know" it in the depths of our soul. That is what that man was crying out for, "LORD! I want to believe!" HE was crying out "Take this shallow intellectual faith in you and create a deep soul belief and hope that you truly can heal my son!"

May we be like that Father crying out to Jesus, "Lord I believe! Help my unbelief!" My plea for all of us is that our hearts would cry out to Jesus: "LORD! I believe that you are good! Help my unbelief!"; "LORD! I believe that you are gracious! Help my unbelief!"; "LORD! I believe that you are gracious! Help my unbelief!"; "LORD! I believe that you began a good work in me and you will complete it! Help my unbelief!"; "LORD! I believe that you have given me the Holy Spirit! Help my unbelief!"; "LORD! Volunteers Needed!


We are in need of people to volunteer to clean our church facilities on High Street. Tasks include:
