# Partially Acknowledging the Lord

ecently I heard Al Gore, a former Vice President of the United States of America, say, "Mother nature is telling us every night on the TV news now is like a nature hike through the book of Revelation. People are noticing this, these downpours and historic floods." I don't know if this statement is true, but I would like to focus on one part of this statement. "...like a nature hike through the book of Revelation."

The calamities that are revealed in the book of Revela-



tion are not caused by man made climate change, but by man made sins. The greatest problems in the world today are those caused by men's sins. There is only one remedy for men's sins and that is Jesus Christ.

You might believe that these are the words of a crazy man and that your Pastor has gone crazy, but I want you to know that I firmly believe in the Word of God. Although I don't know how much of what Al Gore says is true, I wish that if he really believes that the book of Revelation is coming to life that he would take a serious look at all that God says in Revelation.

One can start by looking at Revelation 2 and 3. These two chapters are known as the letters to the seven churches. In each letter to each church it says, "Anyone with ears to hear must listen to the Spirit and understand what he is saying to the churches." To ignore the Lord is to suffer the consequences. However, he warns us of those consequences and therefore we will have no one to blame but ourselves.



To the church in Ephesus (2:4) He says that, "You don't love me or each other as you did at first." To the church in Smyrna (2:10b) He says, "But if you remain faith-

ful even when facing death, I will give you the crown of life." To the church in Pergamum (2:16) He says, "Repent of your sin, or I will come to you suddenly and fight

against them with the sword of my mouth." To the church in Thyatira (2:20-21) He says, "But I have this complaint against you. You are permitting that woman – that Jezebel who calls herself a prophet – to lead my servants astray. She teaches them to commit sexual sin and to eat food offered to idols. I gave her time to repent, but she does not want to turn away from her immorality." To the church in Sardis (3:1b-2) He says, "I know all the things you do, and that you have a reputation of being alive – but you are dead. Wake up! Strengthen what little remains, for even what is left is almost dead. I find that your actions do not meet the requirements of my God." To the church in Philadelphia (3:10) He says, "Because you have obeyed my command to persevere, I will protect you from the great

I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other! So, because you are lukewarm, I will spew thee out of my mouth.

time of testing that will come upon the whole world to test those who belong to this world." Finally, to the church in Laodicea (3:15-16) He says, "I know all the things you do, that you are neither hot nor cold. I wish that you were one or the other! But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit

you out of my mouth!"

However, Revelation 3:20-22 (NLT) says, "Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice 🎇 and open the door, I will come in, and we will share a meal together as friends. Those who are victorious will sit with me on my throne, just I was victorious and sat with

my Father on his throne. Anyone with ears to hear must listen to the Spirit and under-



## **Expensive Tool**

<sup>20</sup> In a wealthy home some utensils are made of gold and silver, and some are made of wood and clay. The expensive utensils are used for special occasions, and the cheap ones are for everyday use. <sup>21</sup> If you keep yourself pure, you will be a special utensil for honorable use. Your life will be clean, and you will be ready for the Master to use you for every good work.

2 Timothy 2:20-21 NLT

Do you ever feel like second class when compared to certain people or jobs? Do you feel like you couldn't do things just as good as others? Or people presumed you couldn't do it because you were too young and inexperienced?

Over the course of many years working in the work force prior to coming on staff and being ordained in the church I've heard these questions from a lot of people about these questions. I to used to also ask these questions while working at certain jobs. At my age now, I tell young people to work hard if you want to climb the ladder, so to speak, and if you want to get that higher position or better pay. Most companies will look at your age to determine if you are qualified, but in my experience some companies will look at people who have great work ethics, work with others, solving issues and takes the initiative to do things without being told.

As Christians it is no different except instead doing things to climb the ladder or better pay we do it to bring glory to God willingly. The above passage is Paul writing to Timothy whom he has left in Ephesus to pastor a church after doing missions going around the regions proclaiming the gospel. Paul is encouraging Timothy that the Lord has a special use for him to do kingdom work on earth.

The reason why I asked you the questions in the beginning is because I want to make sure you understand something in light of the scripture passage. Paul told Timothy if you keep yourself pure you will be used for honorable use. How do you keep yourself pure? The first thing you and I need to be always doing is focusing on our relationship with Christ. To keep ourselves pure is to continue to commit and submit our lives to the Lord in our everyday life.

If Paul is telling Timothy that he is an expensive tool to be used, then, realize we also are an expensive tool. Why do I say that? I want us to realize that every person who believes in Jesus is already an expensive tool because we are going to be used for special occasions or as I said it earlier, for kingdom work on earth. Jesus already sees us as expensive tools because He paid for only the best with His life on the cross. He is redeeming a people for His own. Just as God gathered Israel to be a nation for His own, so He continues to gather people for His own through those who believe in His Son, Jesus. Everyone who becomes a Christian is an expensive tool that will be used for special occasions. Those occasions are to love, share the gospel and make disciples of people in the world. We just need to be told that.

As Paul told Timothy I believe Timothy will tell others and those others will tell still even more, that we are an expensive tool in the Lord's hands.


