Looking for Answers in a Time of Confusion and Distress

In recent weeks, our world, country, state, county, and Leven our own personal lives, we have seen so much

discord, trials, and so much evil. These kinds of traumas create much confusion and distress. Searching for answers in this confused state is very difficult, but not impossible. Keeping our wits sharp, our hearts focused and clear, and all of our faculties well prepped and ready to be utilized are very crucial.

I believe that we are in a time of training and Satan is showing that the battle will soon begin. During this time, it is easy to be distracted by fear and disillusion. Allowing Satan to influence us to take our eyes off of Jesus will be a fatal error. It is important that we remember that Satan is at war against us and his intent is to destroy us. Have you noticed how many illustrations and settings in the Bible are of warfare? God seems to be training and sending us into a life and death struggle for our very souls. It is important that we realize how deadly Satan's attack on us is and that he is playing for keeps. Our only hope is to yield ourselves to Jesus and follow implicitly His commands and desires.

If we attempt to fight this battle in our own strength and wisdom, we are doomed to fail. If we yield ourselves to the master commander and strategist, FGRIKIW we have nothing but victory ahead of the Plane IHWE us. Jeremiah 29:11 (NLT) For I know FORYOU COSE THE the plans I have for you," says the Especial LORD. "They are plans for good and The LARMY HARMY not for disaster, to give you a future and Plans Fok a hope. His training is meant to give us victory when He has to send us into

the battle. Sharp wits, focused hearts, and prepared faculties are crucial to victory. We must take full advantage of the training that He is putting us through because all of this training is conditioning us for maximum effectiveness in the battle. All of the skills and knowledge that training brings to life are meant to be so repetitive that they become second nature so that you don't really have to think too much in the thick of battle. It is therefore so important

to take the training seriously. Stretching your mind and knowledge so that you get the most of the training will really be appreciated when you are in the midst of the battle. Having all of your faculties and equipment in excellent working shape will be of utmost importance.

I want to encourage you to stay focused on Jesus during these times of preparation. Be discipled to become a dis-

devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Your enemy is trying to kill you. The best way for him to accomplish this mission is to mess up your training so that it will not accomplish its purpose. To cause you to misuse and fail to use the faculties and equipment that He has provided for you. To cause your faculties and equipment to become foul and unusable is the goal of the enemy.

Coming through the training, as hard as it might be and as confusing as it can be, will give you all of the answers that you need and desire in this time of confusion and distress. You may face difficulties of all kinds, but the biggest difficulty will be losing faith in Jesus Christ. The testing of your faith during this time of training is the most crucial test of all. James 1:2-4 (NLT) 2 Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. 4 So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you

The Gospel Demands A Response

"Anyone who isn't with me opposes me, and anyone who isn't working with me is actually working against me."

Matthew 12:30 NLT

Jesus is responding to an accusation from the Pharisees when he casts out a demon who had possessed a man, made him blind and unable to speak. The Pharisees claimed that he was working with the demons to perform this miracle. Jesus had some words towards the Pharisees about that, saying that a kingdom divided against itself will fall; a family feud will cause division.

If Satan is fighting against himself that is even more ludicrous. Jesus even turned that kind of thought back to the Pharisees, if you think that about me then what about those of you who perform exorcism? The Pharisees was trying to denounce the claim that people were making when he performed that miracle. They were actually thinking that he was the Messiah and the religious leaders was trying to counter attack those who were thinking and maybe starting to believe in Jesus. They didn't want the people to believe that Jesus could really be the one that God had

sent to save them.

In this situation, what you see are two kinds of responses. There are those who will believe in Jesus and those who will reject him altogether. There will be hatred or passion for Christ.

The only thing I want to point out from this story or situation is this, the gospel demands a response. You might say there could be a third response which is that people could be on

the fence about Jesus. You might hear them say, "Eh" maybe? Understand that still is a rejection.

The gospel is such power that it necessitates reaction. Some will be drawn while others are repulsed by Him. The gospel will either awaken the heart or harden it. I just want you to spend some time with the Lord and dwell over Matthew 12:30. If you and I believe in Jesus then there is work to be done. If we don't believe in Him then there is nothing being done and we are actually working against.

Let me leave you with two questions to talk over with the Lord. What response have you given the Lord? Evaluate your life as a Christian and ask the Lord where do I stand with you, really?


