

# Titus2 Mentoring Women

---

This beautifully designed ministry model is more than a Bible study or book club. The Titus2 Women's Mentoring ministry is a transforming discipleship journey and has proven to be a life-changing experience. For ten months, women will have the opportunity to build spiritual partnerships while cultivating accountability and deepening their commitment to the Lord. By connecting with other women, both the Mentor and other Mentees, will grow in their relationship with Christ and successfully understand and fulfill the unique roles God has placed them in.

## Overview

- Ten months in length. Starting in February and ending in November. Four to six mentee participants in a group
- One monthly meeting lasting three hours with mentoring group
- One weekend retreat in the second or third month with your mentoring group
- Monthly assignments include: reading one book each month, quiet time assignments, memorizing scripture verses, and a personal exercise. If married: marriage exercise and a monthly date night. (about 10-15 hrs per month)
- Monthly meeting with a different Mentee in your group for "Peer-Challenge"
- Meet one-on-one throughout the mentoring year with your Mentor
- Graduation Potluck Dinner

## Important Dates

- Mentee applications received - each fall for the next year's session / Nov. 16, 2017
- Application deadline - Sunday, January 14, 2018 (applications found at [www.valleyreallife.org](http://www.valleyreallife.org) or at VRL office)
- Applicants will be notified sometime during the first week of February regarding acceptance into program and group placement
- Launch Night - Sunday, February 25, 2018, 6:00-9:00 p.m. Valley Real Life  
*\*Launch Night is mandatory for all mentees who have been placed in a mentor group and want to participate in Titus2*

- Women ages 20 and over
- A desire for, and commitment to, personal and spiritual growth in Christ
- Teachable, transparent, and the willingness to be challenged and self-reflective in the mentoring process
- Ability to consistently attend all monthly mentor group meetings and one overnight retreat (retreat to occur within the first three months)
- Ability to complete monthly reading and all homework assignments
- Commitment to pass it on by loving and mentoring another woman or group of women sometime in the future
