



BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF VOLUNTEER POSITIONS FOR BIGTOWN CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Thursday & Sunday Volunteers

Small Group Leaders care for an assigned small group of children each week and consistently connect with their families.

Class Leaders are responsible to oversee and delegate the overall needs of the children within a classroom. They are also small group leaders.

Host Team greets new families as they enter and guides them through the process of checking in to classrooms.

Large Group Storytellers present the Bible story each Sunday in a creative and interactive way so that it captures the attention of children in several age groups. (3's-5's), (K-1st), (2nd-5th)

Worship Leaders & Team Members lead our children in worship with fun music that will inspire them to love and serve God.

Other Volunteer Needs

VBS Leadership is responsible for coordinating our summer week-long day camp for children in Kindergarten-5th grade, "Turn It Up" June 23-27, 2013. VBS leadership is responsible for working with staff and overseeing volunteers.

VBS Volunteers care for an assigned small group of children during our summer week-long day camp, "Turn It Up" June 23-27, 2013. Areas of service: Greeting & Administrative Team, Small Group Team, Production Team, Games & Activities Team, Snack Team, Craft Team, & Large Group Teaching Team. Must be 16 years old or older.

Baby Dedication Ceremony Coordinator is responsible for coordinating and overseeing a baby dedication ceremony two times a year, in May and November; includes coordination and communication with parents, staff and volunteers.

Summer Camp Leaders care for an assigned small group of children during our annual Children's Ministry Summer Camp. Must be 16 years old or older and a week-long overnight stay at camp is required. Summer Camp is August 19-23, 2012.

Special Events Coordinator is responsible for building teams and coordination of events such as the Community Easter Egg Hunt, Family Campout and/or other events as scheduled.

Adopt-A-Classroom is a program where your family or small group can adopt one of our Children's Ministry classrooms and focus on encouraging volunteers, act as subs, decorate the room, visit the kids.
