Group Opener:

When you were young, did the circumstances around you or the people around you have the most influence in defining your identity? What is one example of that—either positive or negative?

Study Questions:

Read Colossians 3:1:17

What do you learn about God in this passage? What do you learn about people?

Why do so many people struggle today finding their identity?

What do you feel influences that struggle the most?

Who does Colossians 3:1-4 say that you are?

Who does other passages in the Bible say you are?

Why do we tend to not listen or remember these things?

What are some practical ways that we can put to death things of our sinful nature? (Col. 3:5-9)

What are some practical ways we can embrace our identity in Christ?

The next step challenge this week is to 1)take one struggle of the flesh (sinful nature) and implement a practical way to combat it; 2)memorize verse 1,2 or 3 from Colossians 3.

From the sermon or the small group discussion, what stuck out to you? Was there something that surprised you, exposed you, informed you, or made you think or pray?
