

### Christian Believer - Tuesday 10:00 AM - Noon or 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM


30 weeks starting August 29  
Study the classical teachings of the Christian faith in a way that can be understood, through the use of words, symbols, and hymns. Over a 30 week period, participants will

examine the writings of ancient and modern theologians and view video presentations by leading Bible scholars. The study guides in daily reading of Scripture and theology. Each lesson includes an explanation and commentary on a specific doctrine, raises questions for the reader, allows for reflection and written response, and suggests ideas for additional reading and study.

8 weeks starting September 13

Have you ever wondered what makes Methodists different? Sure, we believe in the same God as other Christians, however we view our faith through a different lens. This study will help you to recognize the subtle and not-so-subtle differences between John Calvin (Baptist, Presbyterian & Reformed) and John Wesley (Methodist, Nazarene & Wesleyan). Both Calvin and Wesley wrote about major tenets of the church: who God is, and what God's will is for us; the place of Scripture; the atonement of Christ; the role of human responsibility; the work of God's grace; the relation of the church and world; and how these beliefs can influence our practice of faith.

**International:** *Hope Secondary School, Israel/Palestine*; Education is a basic right for all children around the world, yet in many parts of the West Bank children are not receiving a proper education. For those who do receive an education, one in five will not make it past the fifth grade. The ministry is a secondary school educating and boarding disadvantaged children from the West Bank in a caring Christian environment.

**Domestic:** *Lydia Patterson Institute, El Paso, Texas*; The school is providing quality education and forming bilingual and bicultural leaders for the church and society. Ninety-five percent of the students who graduate from LPI go to college. The goal is to attain 100%, while preparing more students for the ministry and identifying more students called to the ordained ministry.
