LOOKING AT

**Read the following verse out loud
and discuss how it applies to your lives:**

God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus. **PHILIPPIANS 4:19 (NIV)**

LOOKING IN

Reflect & share your responses with the group:

God's provision is not based on your assets. It's based on what God has and He doesn't run out of resources. This is a promise only for believers. He is basically saying, "If you're one of My children, in My family, I promise to meet all your needs."

- » Why do you have financial struggles or challenges of any kind?
- » Why does there continue to be believers that struggle with not having enough?
- » Knowing we all have struggles, how are you able to hold fast to God's promise that He will provide all that you need? Do you ever doubt that God will provide?

LOOKING AT

**Read the following verse out loud
and discuss how it applies to your lives:**

Your heavenly Father already knows perfectly well that you need them, and He will give them to you if you give him first place in your life and live as He wants you to. **MATTHEW 6:32-33 (TLB)**

LOOKING IN

Consider the following statement and discuss as a group:

God's promises of provision have conditions attached. It's as if God is saying, "I'll do my part and you do your part." Assess and share how you are doing with "your part."

Ask yourself...am I (1) Asking Him for help? (2) Learning to be content? (3) Practicing giving in faith? (4) Maintaining my integrity? (5) Trusting Him with my life?

LOOKING AROUND

Brainstorm the following as a group:

- »» What are some practical ways that could help you "do your part?"

LOOKING UP

Pair up with two others in your group.

Pray for God to help with your fears of not having enough.

LOOKING OUT

Believe that God IS who He says He IS and that God will DO what He said He is going to DO.
