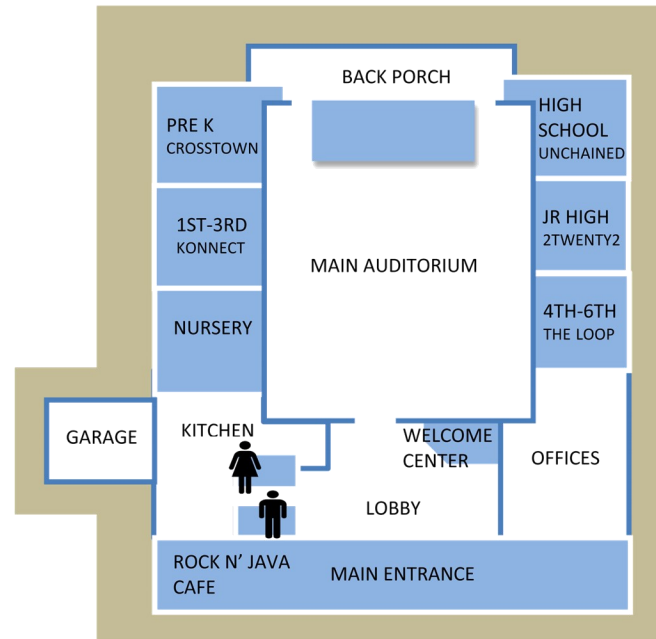


WHAT NEW PEOPLE WANT TO KNOW

GOOD FEAR

There's good fear and bad fear and sometimes we get to choose. Leslie and I were laughing when she told me that recently a coworker surprised her (scared her) when he came around a corner unexpectedly. Her first reaction was to throw punches. Thankfully, none of them landed.

Life will at times come 'round the corner and catch us off guard – frighten us. Health. Finances. Relationships. Even when we try to expect the unexpected, when it comes, it feels like we got jumped. It happens to us ALL. This is an unavoidable kind of bad fear that we do not choose. But, there's a better fear. A chosen fear. It comes when we decide to step up to the line to do something that will greatly test us, help someone else, and possibly (probably) hurt a little. We don't have to do it. We choose it. It involves a good kind of fear.

If you have chosen to do really hard, really positive things that you know will help others and also better equip you, you have experienced this kind of "good fear". When you have committed to something you KNOW is way beyond what you think you can do...or even want to do. There's good nerves. Good butterflies. Can I do this? Will I quit? Am I gonna look dumb if I try this? Right? It comes with stepping up to answer the call to do the stuff that really matters. And when we choose to walk through this kind of fear – guess what! It greatly helps us when we are faced with the bad kind of "didn't see that comin'" kind of fear. We're much, much stronger.

Examine your life and be honest about the level of challenge you are willing to step up to. Does your experience of loving God and serving Him scare you at least a little? That's good, good fear that we choose. -Toby
