I immediately wanted everybody to know that <u>I</u> thought it up myself – didn't get it from him...*PRIDE!* 

## 2. COMMIT TO DEEPEN YOUR UNDERTANDING OF JESUS' HUMILITY

How do you do it? My approach would be to begin reading through the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) and noting every humble thing Jesus did and said. Ask yourself: would I do that? Then to take it further, start reading the letters Paul wrote (Romans, Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, etc.) because one of his favorite topics is how humble Jesus is. You can Google specific verses on the topic and commentaries. The more we truly understand how He loved and how selfless He lived, the clearer we can see the pride in our lives and how we should instead live.

## 3. PRAY THAT GOD WILL MAKE YOUR <u>PRIDE</u> MORE OBVIOUS THIS WEEK.

I'm anxious for us to get this going...this week! We have three weeks to experience this topic so I pray we'll get started by a true evaluation of where we are in this area. How prideful am I? How prideful are you? Are we blind to a lot of it? Ask God to show it to you and then we can really begin really working on it.
