TAKEAWAYS

1. KEEP UP AND STUDY UP

Do you know what you know? Do you know what you don't know? Take a look outside your church circle and learn what the world is wrestling with. Do an honest assessment of whether you'd know what to say to the classmate/colleague/cousin with legitimate questions.

2. CHOOSE YOUR MOMENTS WELL

Remember that a good argument will fall on deaf ears if the person hearing it isn't open to it. Ask God for the wisdom and discernment to understand when to speak up and when to walk away.

3. KEEP LOVE FRONT AND CENTER

If you're naturally into this stuff, remember that nobody likes a know-it-all or someone who's so puffed up with knowledge that they forget to care about people. Remember that the purpose of learning and growing in our understanding of God and his principles should be to help others. Listen first to where others are coming from, then respond with gentleness and respect.

If you're **not** inclined to learn apologetics/philosophy/rhetoric as a hobby, let a real desire to bring the right tools to the rescue mission motivate you. You don't have to become a scholar, but love will require us to know the basics and where to find more answers.

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
