WEEK 1: MARY - LUKE 1:39-56

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: God, we come to encounter you in worship on this day.

People: We come with all our uncertainties and fears and frailties.

L: We come to worship in spirit and truth.

P: We are your servants. May it be to us according to your word.

ALL: Let us worship God!

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Holy God, you promised to do great things for us, yet we do not trust you. You extend your mercy to us, yet we do not trust you. You lift up the humble, you fill the hungry with good things, and yet we still do not trust you. Forgive us, and help us to trust in the promises you have given us. In the name of Jesus Christ we pray. Amen.

WEEK 2: SIMEON AND ANNA - LUKE 2:21-40

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: Prophets and seers have called you blessed, O Jesus.

People: We come today to call you blessed, too.

L: We know of your life and your sacrifice,

P: your resurrection and our salvation.

ALL: Let us now worship you in awe and in joy.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

God, you have revealed yourself to us in your son, Jesus. And yet we do not always recognize him as our savior. We do not understand the full truth in his life, death, and resurrection. Help us to be more like Simeon and Anna, who saw Jesus for who he was, even as a little baby. Forgive our unbelief and help our faith to grow through the power of your Holy Spirit in our lives. We pray this through Jesus Christ. Amen.

WEEK 3: PEOPLE OF NAZARETH - LUKE 4:14-30

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: The Spirit of the Lord is upon us!

People: God has anointed us to bring good news to the poor,

L: To proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind,

P: to set the oppressed free.

ALL: Let us worship the God of justice and peace!

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

God, we do not understand Jesus, the prophet. We do not want to get our hands dirty with the poor, the oppressed, the prisoners. Forgive us for being insulated and isolated. Open our hearts to the poor and help us to love them as you love them, working to bring in the good news of the reign of God. In Christ's name we pray. Amen.

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: We gather this day to worship you, O Holy One.

People: We are thankful for your gift of unconditional love and grace.

ALL: Be with us and guide us by the power of your Holy Spirit that we may worship you in Spirit and in truth. Amen.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

God of grace and God of glory, we come to you as sinful people. We live sinful lives and often turn away from you. We don't understand the depth of your love or your truth. Forgive us, and help us to show the love that you have given us to others. Help us to live our lives for you. Let us always remember that you tell us that our sins are forgiven. Thank you, Jesus. Amen.

WEEK 5: CRIPPLED WOMAN AND RELIGIOUS RULER - LUKE 13: 10-17

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: Come, all you who are struggling.

People: Come, all you who are crippled by pain and suffering.

L: Come to worship a God who heals your pain.

P: Come to worship a God who gives forgiveness.

ALL: Let us worship God, who sets us free and gives us new life!

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

We come to you, O God, weighed down by the power of our burdens. We want to trust you, understand you and experience your love. Send us your grace and set us free from the burden of sin. Help us to recognize your love and your grace, which does indeed set us free. Thank you God, for forgiveness which is new each day. Through Christ we pray. Amen.

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: Healer God, we come to you today seeking to be made whole.

People: We come as a people seeking to worship you.

L: We rejoice!

P: That this is the day the Lord has made!

ALL: Come let us expect healing and worship the Sovereign Lord of all!

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

O God, so often we take you for granted. We take for granted that you will answer our prayers, that you will heal us and make us whole. We take for granted that you love us. Forgive us for not appreciating your grace and presence in our lives. Help us to be more thankful. Give us faith to see you in everything and everyone around us, so that we may be truly grateful. In Christ's name we pray. Amen.

P: Let us give of ourselves in this worship time that we may know God.

ALL: Let us joyfully and with gratitude worship God!

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

O God, sometimes we cannot see you. We search for you and have to strain to hear your voice. And yet you come to us where we are, in our sinful lives. You forgive us and change our hearts through the grace of your son, Jesus and his liberating love. Forgive us again and again as we thank you for your presence in our lives. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

WEEK 8: A MAN NAMED BARNABAS - ACTS 4: 32-37

CALL TO WORSHIP

ALL: Come, let us worship God as a community of faith drawn together by the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. Let us be like Barnabas, generous and encouraging of one another. Let us worship the God who calls us to be one in heart and mind. Hallelujah! Let us worship God!

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

O God, we yearn to be a community of believers, united in your Spirit. And yet we are fraught with divisions: denominational, political, theological. We are weighed down by tensions and the things that break us apart. Forgive us, great God, for this great sin. Help us to learn to live in community together, loving one another, in spite of our differences, and respecting one another in everything that we do and say. Help us to be as you call us, one in heart and mind. Only through the grace of your son, Jesus Christ, can we achieve this. Amen.

WEEK 9: A MAN CALLED STEPHEN - ACTS 6

CALL TO WORSHIP

Leader: As we gather to worship, let us remember the poor.

People: As we gather to worship, let us remember the widows.

L: As we gather to worship, let us remember the sick and those who are in prison.

P: As we gather to worship, let us remember the vulnerable and the weak.

ALL: Let us now worship the God of the poor, the widows, the sick, those who are in prison, the vulnerable and the weak. Let us worship the God who loves us all and calls us to be with the least of these, our brothers and sisters in Christ. Amen.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

God of the poor and oppressed, we come to you as people who have ignored your pleas to be with the least of these. We are often so concerned with our own lives and the riches and material things we want to gather, that we forget your command to love others as you have loved us. We forget your command to love the poor, to take care of the widow and the orphan, to love those on the margins. Forgive us, and help us to have open hearts, to love and give with compassion and grace, just as your disciple Stephen did. In Christ's name we pray. Amen.

CALL TO WORSHIP

We don't want to love the unlovable in our eyes, when you love everyone. Thank you that you love us and forgive us of our sin of exclusion. Continue to help us grow in love for those we think we cannot love. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
