

Week #27- “Road Trip with Jesus”

Luke 24:13-35

Accountability

- How are you doing in the area of sharing the love of Christ to those around you (school, work place, home)? How did God use you to show up in someone's life this past week?
- Where did you see God at work this past week?

Understanding and Applying the Passage *(Read Luke 24:13-35)*

- Missing Jesus. Read Luke 24:13-24. Why did the men not recognize Jesus? Why do you think this happened?
- What did Jesus ask the men in verses 17 and 19? How did the men respond? How did the men “miss” Jesus in verse 21? How did they miss Him in their account of the empty tomb? How do we miss Jesus today? How do we miss the Gospel today?
- Read Luke 24:25-27. How did Jesus respond to the men in verses 25 and 26? What did He do in verse 27? What does this tell us about the Old Testament? How do we experience Jesus in the scriptures? Spend some time discussing how the whole Bible is about Him (e.g., where do we see Jesus in Genesis – Deuteronomy?). How does this fortify the validity of the Bible? The Gospel?
- Read Luke 24:28-31. When do the men know this man is Jesus? Why is this action significant (where have we seen Him break bread before)? How does this account speak to the sovereignty of God?
- How did the men react to this realization of Jesus in verse 32? How did they respond in verses 33-35? How does the reality of Christ in the totality of scripture and in the power of the Spirit bring you to worship?
- How does the reality of Christ fuel our mission?
- What helps you recognize that it is Jesus who is walking alongside you when you are discouraged or confused?
- If Jesus showed up among us right now, but we did not recognize Him, what insightful question do you think He would ask this group?
- If Jesus were to walk a few miles with you today, what would you talk with Him about?
- If you were to identify the top three reason why it can be hard for people to believe what Jesus says, what top three reasons would you give?
- If an unbeliever asked you, what practical difference does Jesus make in your life? What would you tell them?

What’s the “Big Idea” from God’s word that we need to make sure we wrestle with today?
