Partners in Christ:

God has showered us in incredible blessings. Spiritual, Financial Goals;

As we have discovered in our "Finding Financial Peace" series, our finances are a major part of our spiritual lives. Our relationship with Jesus should show itself in how we manage the gifts God has given us. We have also discovered that if we are not careful in managing our blessings they can enslave us, frustrate us, and get in the way of our relationship with Jesus.

During the next week, commit yourself to pray and seek God's plan for your life. Consider the blessings He has given to you. Discover in your heart how you want to respond to His gifts. Examine your life; what would you invite Jesus to change in your financial life? Do you want to change the way you see money or success? Is something standing in the way of living out your desire to give thanks? Are there debts you need to pay off? Is there a purchase you shouldn't make? Do you need to reach out for help? Is God calling you to offer wisdom and guidance to others?

Plan your goals


Fill out your pledge card

Your pledge card is a tool for personal growth and reflection. It will not be used to plan the church budget, nor will anyone but you know what you have pledged.

Write your goals on the pledge card using the back (don't write on the back of the cut-offs!) if you need more space. Also write your goals on the Bible/Checkbook cut-off so that you can reflect on them during the year.

Write your firstfruits giving goals on the card. The card will help you to calculate your typical gift and your annual goal. It will also help you to consider your gift as a percentage of your income to encourage firstfruits thinking. Don't forget to keep a record of your goal on the Bible/Checkbook cut-off. Finally, write your annual goal on the anonymous cut-off.

Return your Pledge Card



Cut off the cut-offs. Place the Bible/Checkbook portion in your Bible or checkbook. Place the center portion in a sealed envelope with your name on it. You will receive this unopened next year. Bring the sealed envelope and the pledge cut-off with you to church on Sunday November 28th. During the service you will be invited to present them to God on the altar.
