


"For if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."

MAN'S ATTEMPT TO GET RIGHT WITH GOD


Throughout time, man has tried many different ways to get right with God. But none of man's ways are successful.

Believe

God Has Provided The Way
