

Our Journey of Faith Continues



After focusing on *Our Wesleyan Roots* in September and *The Sacred Word* in October, Wesley's *Journey of Faith* continues in November with an emphasis on *Prayer*. Pastor Jerry provided a segue by preaching on October 29 on how we use the Bible, including its role as a focus for prayer and devotional life.

On Sunday, November 12, we will host the third special event in our *Journey*. As with past gatherings, a light supper will be served at 5:00, this time in the Fellowship Room on the main floor alongside the sanctuary. Rev. Mark Ellingson, lead chaplain at Altru, then will present a program of interest on the month's topic of *Prayer*.

An interesting guide to our topic of prayer has been mailed to leaders of our congregation for use in the various classes and other gatherings in our church. Additional copies of the guide are available for any interested persons at the Welcome Center table in the church lobby. Also as part of our *Journey of Faith*, the Wesley Endowment trustees granted funding to provide *Upper Room* devotional booklets for all persons in the church. If you did not receive a copy in worship, please take one from the table at the Welcome Center – and feel free to take additional copies to give to family members, friends, co-workers, and neighbors.

During November worship services, Pastor Jerry will be preaching about some of the different ways we can pray to God, focusing on inward prayers (today), upward prayers (Nov. 12), and outward prayers (Nov. 19).

Charge Conference – Sunday, November 19

On Sunday, Nov. 19, Wesley will be the site for a charge conference meeting for all of the United Methodist Churches from Hillsboro to the Canadian border. Beginning at 2:00, our District Superintendent Randy Cross will lead us in devotion and instruction. We will hear some news from each of our regional churches. Continued Partnership with Head Start



For a number of years, Wesley UMC members shopped each holiday season to provide Christmas gifts for Grand Forks Head Start children and their siblings. Due to a variety of factors, Head Start leaders have decided to end that cooperative activity. However, we still want to maintain a partnership to provide for children's needs. Therefore, during the month of November, we will be accepting new and like-new children's winter wear (coats, jackets, caps, mittens, scarves, and boots), particularly those sizes for ages 3-6.

We also would like to collect enough board games and other family-oriented games appropriate for children 3-6 years of age to give one to every Head Start family. That means we would need to receive over 150 games by the end of November. Pastor Jerry is confident that we can do this, so watch for the early season toy sales and bring newly purchased (not used) games to church (wrapped or unwrapped).
