JULY MISSION PROJECT: UMCOR SCHOOL BAGS



The Missions Ministry Team has designated MMDC School Kits (Midwest Mission Distribution Center) as our July Missions Project. In some countries, children don't have books or school supplies. The school kits might be these children's only educational resources.

School bags have recently been shipped to Haiti & multiple countries in Central America. They also go to local service organizations and multiple areas around the Midwest and neighboring states such as Appalachian areas in Kentucky and Ohio.

WHEN SHOPPING FOR JULY MISSION SCHOOL SUPPLIES, please follow this MMDC School Bag Shopping List:

- 3 spiral, one-subject spiral notebooks (8" x 10 1/2")
- 3 pens (blue or black)
- 3 unsharpened pencils
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 pencil eraser (2" or larger)
- 1 ruler 12" long with metric
- 1 box of <u>24</u> crayons (Crayola preferred)
- 1 pair round tip scissors (no plastic scissors)

Monetary gifts will be used to cover shipping

expenses from Midwest Mission Distribution Center where the school bags are checked and filled for shipping. This usually totals about \$150. Any contributions over \$150 will be used to buy additional school supplies.

Seven inches of rain over the first three days didn't dampen the spirits of the twenty Wesley boy scouts who had a great week at Rhodes-France Scout Reservation near Pana. Family members joined them for a Wednesday evening potluck, then stayed for the camp's impressive fire bowl ceremony during which scouts, including six from Troop 141, were "tapped out" as candidates for membership in the Order of the Arrow, scouting's honorary brotherhood.

Five scouts and three adults depart on July 7 for a week of backpacking in the Porcupine Mountain wilderness along the Lake Superior coast of Michigan's upper peninsula.

Troop 141 has offered the use of our canoes and kayaks for Embarras River outings by the scouts of Pastor Corum's former church, Troop 1 at Champaign First UMC, and also alerted them to the great trails available here.

In recent service projects, our scouts built two monkey bridges at the Lake Shelbyville Visitor's Center for children to clamber on at the Army Corps of Engineers summer youth program and manned a water station on the 50-mile route during the Tour de Charleston bike race.


