I mean just think about it...

Does Taylor Swift have to declare that she can sing?

Does Michael Jordan have to declare he can dunk a basketball?

Does Nita Gwynne have to declare she loves children?

Does Keith Kilpatrick have to declare that he loves our students at West Main?

Does Jason Kraft have to declare that he can preach really well?

The answer to these questions is a BIG FAT NO!!! People aren't who they are because of what they are declaring, but rather because of what they are doing.

Anyone can declare that they can do something, but a really wise man (JESUS) once said that wisdom is proved right by actions (doing) and not merely by declaration! (That's a paraphrase of Matthew 11:19)
