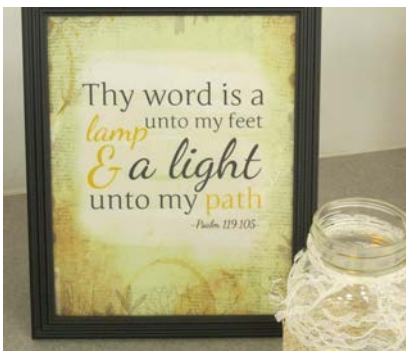

December 9th – Youth fundraising luncheon.

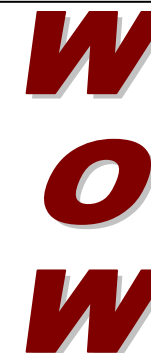
December 13th – Christmas gathering at the home of the Greene's.
