- All children’s classes are located in the children’s wing on the third floor.



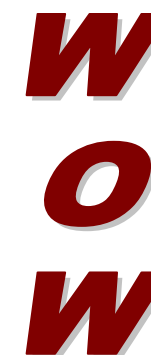
