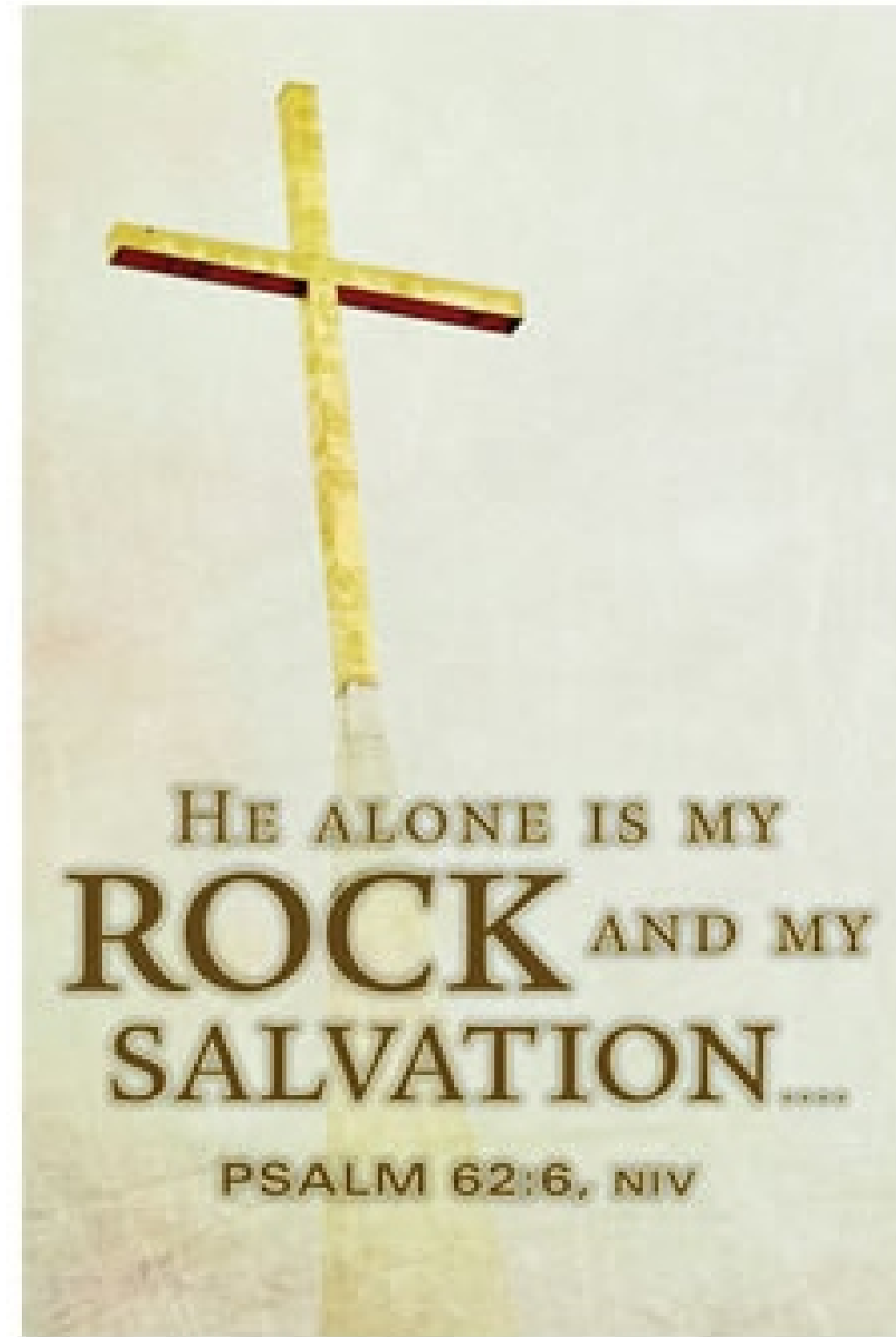

The Abel Pregnancy Resource Center will be holding a 24-hour prayer vigil on March 14th for the U.S. Supreme Court case NIFLA v Becerra which will be heard on March 20. This case has to do with forcing pro-life pregnancy centers to provide free advertising for tax-funded abortions and compelling staff and volunteers to violate their consciences and promote abortion. The media is calling this case, "the most important free speech case in a generation," with "significant and far-reaching ramifications."
