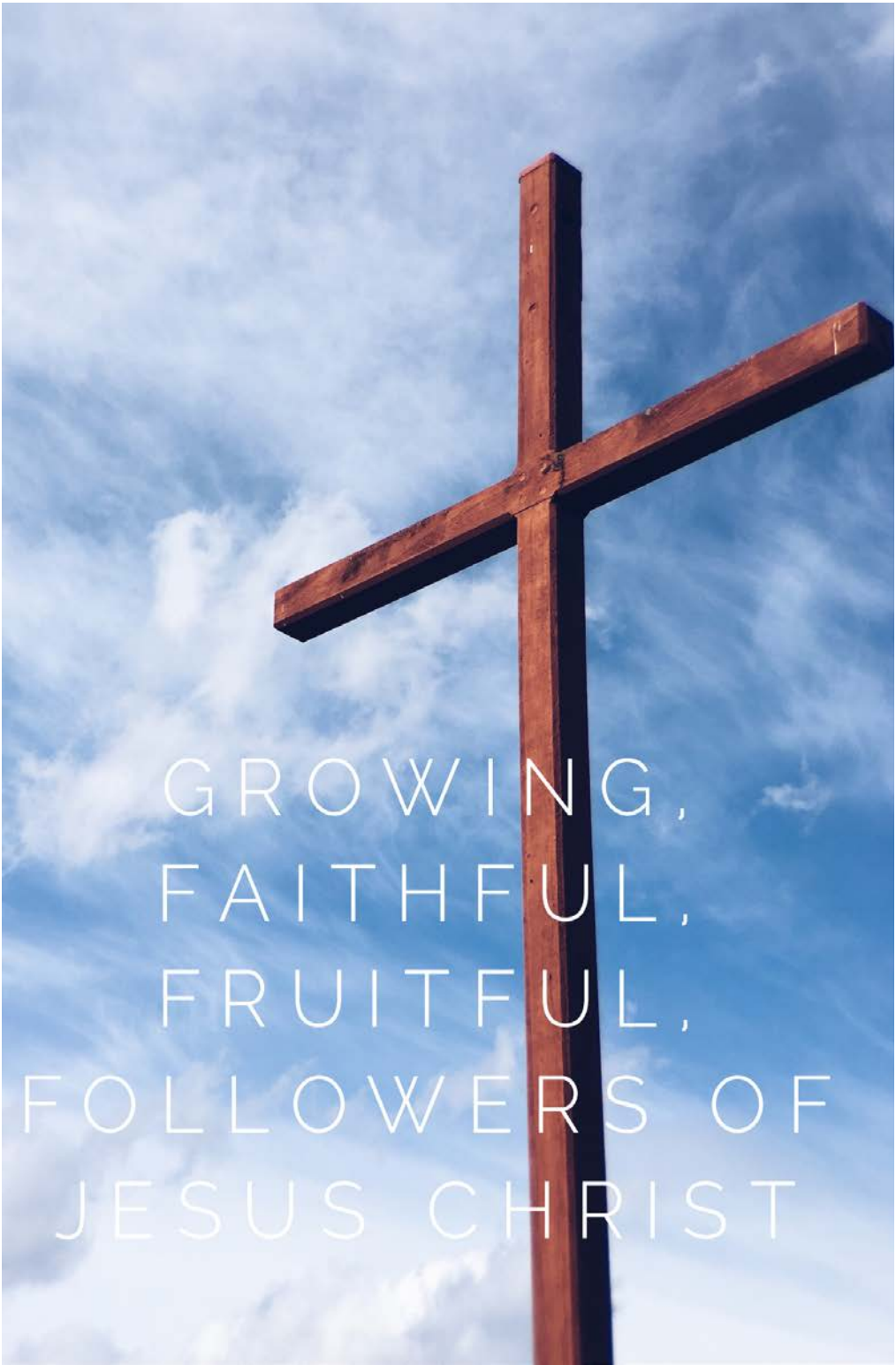
- Parents are encouraged to use our nursery during the worship service located in Rooms 201/203 in the Children's Wing.
