Dear Church Family,

I hope that just because we are finished with the "Not a Fan" book in our LifeGroups that we don't just put it on the shelf. What a challenging book! As a matter of fact, I would like for us to focus on one of the challenges that was presented in the "Not a Fan" book.

"Am I really carrying a cross if there is no suffering and sacrifice? When is the last time that following Jesus cost you something? When is the last time it cost you a relationship? When is the last time following Jesus cost you a promotion? When is the last time it cost you a vacation? When is the last time you were mocked for your faith? Forget about having our lives threatened... When is the last time you went without a meal for the sake of the gospel? Can you really say you are carrying your cross if it hasn't cost you anything? Take a second and answer that question in your mind. Has it cost you anything?
