Training Sessions 2014:

Wednesday 12th February for iserv applicants and their parents, 7-9 pm.

One Sunday morning training session in July school holidays

iserv volunteers serve at one Sunday service, every Sunday during term time

First service: 8am—10am

Third service: 10.45am—12.45pm

iserv volunteers will be placed in service roles to experience different areas according to their skills, talents and interests.

Volunteers are expected to be team players and support what the team is doing.
