Kitchen Table Questions

Ask your parents to put themselves into Mary Magdalene's shoes, a woman who was once possessed by seven demons who then went on to travel around with Jesus and the disciples. What would that be like knowing that everyone knew your past struggles? Would you fit in?

How would you feel if you had heard the great news that Jesus had been resurrected—and then nobody believed you! Would you be frustrated? Dissatisfied? Or would you feel proud knowing that even though nobody believed you, God still picked you to be the first to know?
