Restructuring of Nursery/Preschool Program

We are excited to let you know that we have begun to restructure our nursery and preschool age classes due to our growing congregation and the needs of these children. In December of 2010 a two year olds class was started. This class takes place during Sunday morning class time and Wednesday nights. The class is held in the nursery where the cradle roll room was held (room 101). Children from 24 months - 36 months are welcome in this class.

We are also working on restructuring the 3's & 4's class. This is currently a work in progress and will not be fully implemented until June 2011. Currently, if you have a child that is 3 or has just turned 4 they should be going to this class. If your child is 4 but is close to 5 years old please feel free to leave them in their current classroom. Starting in June of 2011 all children that are 3 or 4 will meet in classroom 102. They will be promoted into the next class once they turn five or begin kindergarten.

How can you help? We will need teachers and helpers for these two classes. There is a sign up sheet on the bulletin board that has been posted in the nursery. We would like to staff each classroom with one teacher and one helper. The teacher and helper need to be willing to teach for a one month period- both Sundays and Wednesday nights. The curriculum is provided and very easy to follow. There are no preparations needed for the 2's class but there may be some craft preparations for the 3 & 4's class. If you have never taught before this is a great place to start. Your help is truly appreciated and will make a big difference in the lives of these children.

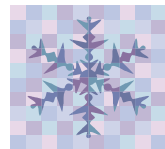
