## “A Day with Doc”

I recently played golf with a fellow who claims that he “can't walk as fast as he used to.” And he has a good excuse . . . he's 90 years old. His name is Kenneth O'Brien. His friends call him “Doc”.

Dr O'Brien practiced medicine for many years. He retired about eight years ago, at the age of 82. Now he spends his time playing golf (twice a week) and working for the Lord. At least twice every week, “Doc” comes to the church building and makes phone calls to our elderly and shut-ins. He loves people. He loves the church. And he loves Jesus.

A few days ago I asked “Doc” what advise he would give to our young people. His answer: “Keep breathing.” Well, for over 90 years, “Doc” has been breathing, and like the Energizer Bunny, he just keeps on going and going and going.

The greatest years of a person's life may be when he is old. Want a few Biblical illustrations?

Noah was 600 years old when he entered the ark (Genesis 7:6).

Abraham was 75 years old when God told him to move (Genesis 12:4).

Sarah was 90 years old (Doc's age) when she gave birth to a baby (Genesis 17:17).

Jacob was 147 years old when he gave some great advice (Genesis 47:28).

Moses was 80 years old when he led a nation out of slavery (Acts 7:30 cf Exodus 3).

Paul was an old man when he wrote a masterpiece on forgiveness (Philemon 9).

My grandmother (mother's mom) died in August of 2009. Like Lois in the life of Timothy ( II Timothy 1:5), my grandmother taught me scripture. She was “faithful till death” (Revelation 2:10). Guess how old she was when she died. Try 105.

Hang in there, “Doc”. You have 15 more years.
