TIM TALK

Despite growing up a devout fan of University of Tennessee football, I also grew up to appreciate Paul Bryant. Bryant, aka "Bear," was arguably one of the best college football coaches in the history of the game. In his 38 seasons as a head coach, he had winning records in all but one.

His first national championship came while at the helm of Kentucky's program. He would add six more championships once he got to Alabama, his alma mater, along with 8 more conference titles. His teams won 15 post-season bowl games. His winning percentage (including his time at Maryland, Kentucky, Texas A&M and Alabama) stands at just over 76%.

One could probably argue the ins and outs of his coaching style. His introduction of the wishbone offense in the latter years of his tenure at Alabama point to his serious study of the game and it's progress.

But what stands out to me is the fact that the Bear was not afraid to stand on his principles. Biographers suggest that he left Maryland after only one season because those in power wanted him to compromise his integrity. (You have to think the Terps regretted that decision for years to come.) I do not know if he was a Christian, though Robert Shuller shares an interesting story about a spiritual meeting with the Bear on a plane. Yet there was a spiritual foundation to this giant of a coach.

Below is a poem that Bryant reputedly kept in his pocket as a daily reminder of the importance of making every day count. Perhaps this is the thought behind what Paul meant in Ephesians 5.16, when he wrote about "redeeming the time." Some other versions speak of "making the most of every opportunity." Consider the words of this poem, author unknown, as a motivator to make a difference for Jesus. Until we meet again... TWP

*This is the beginning of a new day.
God has given me this day to use as I will.
I can waste it or use it for good.
What I do today is important as I am exchanging a day of my life for it.
When tomorrow comes, this day will be gone forever.
Leaving something in its place I have traded for it.
I want it to be a gain, not loss,
Good, not evil,
Success, not failure, Regret
In order that I shall not ~~forget~~ the price I paid for it.*
