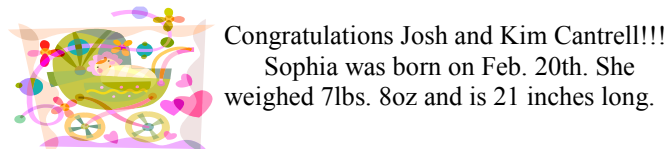

No Children's Worship Today



TIM TALK

There is a little volume that sits on the bookshelf in my office as a sort-of colorful decoration on an otherwise drab collection of books. It is a compilation of selections from the writings of C.S. Lewis, drawing from his books *The Great Divorce*, and *The Problem of Pain*, along with a sermon titled "The Weight of Glory." Lewis was born into the Church of Ireland, but in his teenage years became an atheist. In later years, he would find a new faith in God, and would become one of the greatest influences in Christian apologetics in the 20th Century.

Often I am challenged in reading Lewis. He was a brilliant man who sometimes writes in a deep literary style. But it is not the intellectual depth that challenges me; rather it is how poignant his words are to my life in Christ today.

I picked up *Made for Heaven* today to do some devotional reading. The particular part I turned to spoke so strongly to me that I re-read it several times. I confess I was convicted by his words, and forced to confront my own attitude with prayer.

The passage I read dealt with the Christian's view of self-denial. Lewis was making the point that it is neither sinful nor unspiritual to desire the rewards promised by Christianity. That was not the convicting part for me. Rather, it was the part that dealt with the Christian's exchange of the greater spiritual rewards in Christ with the things of the here and now.

As you read the following words, reflect seriously on your own satisfaction with the things of life. Meditate especially on the implications of the last sentence below. What pleases you? How do you let that pleasure affect your walk with the Lord? Do you find your greatest satisfaction in earthly pleasures or is there a hunger in you for something more? I pray that you feel that hunger intensely. I will tell you that it can only be filled by and with Christ Himself.

Indeed if we consider the unblushing promises of reward and the staggering nature of the rewards promised in the Gospels, it would seem that Our Lord finds our desires not too strong, but too weak. We are half-hearted creatures, fooling about with drink and sex and ambition when infinite joy is offered us, like an ignorant child who wants to go on making mud pies in a slum because we cannot imagine what is meant by the offer of a holiday at the sea. We are far too easily pleased.
